

GOAL 3 INSTITUTIONALIZE THE SLDS

To improve quality of life, education and employment opportunities for all citizens, the State of Mississippi has committed to developing and maintaining a State Longitudinal Data System (SLDS). The system will allow stakeholders and policymakers to generate information from data in a manner that crosses institutional boundaries and provides decision makers a tool to develop policies with an eye toward improving educational achievement and economic competitiveness.

Having a statewide data system in place will allow for easy access to metadata and longitudinal data that can be used to gauge program effectiveness and promote innovative information management to increase economic competitiveness across the state. In Mississippi, the SLDS has been designed to build upon and complement existing data systems within agencies and state entities involved in education and workforce development. These groups will send data from their internal systems to the Statewide Longitudinal Data System.
